The Embassy of India organized open house on 26 May, 2023, which was chaired by H.E. Ambassador Piyush Srivastava. The Embassy's consular team and panel of lawyers were also present. More than 60 Indian nationals participated in the Open House.

Ambassador thanked the community for their overwhelming participation in various events held during the visit of Shri V. Muraleedharan, Minister of State for External Affairs (MoS), Government of India.

Ambassador expressed happiness at resolution of most of the issues raised at the last open House. He conveyed his gratitude to the local authorities for their prompt support and co-operation. Eight (8) stranded Indian workers travelled back to India with the intervention of the Embassy and with the support & co-operation of Labour Marketing Regulatory Authority (LMRA), Bahrain.

The Embassy continued to help distressed Indian nationals including housemaids by providing boarding and accommodation, as well as granting Emergency certificates and tickets to persons in need through the ICWF.

It was a productive interactive session. The grievances/issues of the Indian community were successfully addressed; some resolved at the open house, while others will be taken up at the earliest possible. Ambassador thanked all the Indian associations and community members for their active participation in the open house.
