PRESS RELEASE

The Ambassador Piyush Srivastava, along with the Embassy Consular Team and our panel lawyers interacted with around 50 Indian community members regarding their urgent/long pending consular and labour grievances at the Open House organised by the Embassy on 26 August 2022 between 10:00 hrs to 12:00 hrs. Heads and Representatives of Indian associations including ICRF, World NRI Council, BKS and IHRC were also present.

Ambassador expressed happiness at the overwhelming participation of Indian community members at the Flag Hoisting Ceremony and the evening Reception organized by the Embassy, as well as in the events organized by our community organizations to celebrate 75th anniversary of India's Independence.

On this momentous occasion, Ambassador also visited the MCSC WLL Labour camp and interacted with more than 800 Indian workers and the company management. The Embassy officers visited Jau jail wherein they interacted with the inmates and distributed sweets & snacks on the occasion of Independence Day.

Ambassador expressed his gratitude to the local government authorities including Ministry of Labour, Labour Market Regularity Authority (LMRA) and Immigration authorities, as well as appreciated Indian associations and volunteers for their continued support and assistance in resolving a number of issues concerning our community members.

The case of salary issues pertaining to the workers of ASILON Contracting and Magnum Ship Care Company were also successfully resolved with the intervention of Embassy and also the support of Local authorities. Around 21 workers of the above said company were benefitted.

Ambassador informed the community members that many of the families of the deceased received death compensation with the intervention of the Embassy. He also informed that around 16 jail inmates were provided financial assistance through ICWF for issuing Emergency certificates and one inmate was facilitated with air passage.

It was a productive interactive session. Ambassador thanked all the Indian associations and community members for their active participation in the open house.
