The Embassy of India organized open house on 24 February, 2023, which was chaired by the Ambassador. The Embassy's consular team and panel of lawyers were also present. Around 60 Indian nationals took part in the grievance redressal process.

Ambassador praised the Indian community and organizations for collaborating with the Embassy to successfully resolve a number of consular and labor issues.

Ambassador thanked Labour Marketing Regulatory Authority (LMRA) for their support in organising a "Labour Registration Programme" for the first time at Embassy's premises. He expressed his happiness on the huge success of the event, with approximately 250 Indian community members attending and learning about LMRA's new program through their presentation.

Ambassador invited the Community members to participate in the Qawwali night held on 07 March, 2023 at 8 pm, led by the renowned musician Nawaz Sabri as part of Spring of Culture festival hosted by Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities.

The Open House platform enables people to directly address Ambassador about their issues, allowing pending cases to be resolved more quickly. Most of the cases which were raised during the last open house have been successfully resolved. The Embassy continued to assist distressed house maids by providing boarding and lodging, as well as issuing Emergency certificates and tickets to distressed people through ICWF.

It was a productive interactive session. The Ambassador thanked all of the Indian associations and community members for their active participation in the open house.
