Remarks by H.E., Mr. Vinod K Jacob, Ambassador of India at the ceremony to felicitate the newly appointed Global Chairman of GOPIO, Mr. Sunny Kulathackal organised by GOPIO Bahrain Chapter on 14 October 2023

It is now our responsibility to renew these contacts in the contemporary period. I am committed to working with the Kingdom of Bahrain to strengthen cooperation and hope that GOPIO will also play it's part in this regard.
